*WHEREAS*, a permanent, year-round water conservation measures are in effect throughout the Suwannee River Water Management District; and

*WHEREAS*, the City of Alachua supports and promotes the efficient use of Florida's water resources; and

*WHEREAS*, local governments are essential in assisting in promoting water conservation awareness and implementing water conservation measures; and

*WHEREAS*, every agricultural operation, business, industry, school, resident and visitor can help by conserving water and thus promote a healthy economy and community; and

*WHEREAS*, every citizen can help save water by following the Suwannee River Water Management District's year-round water conservation measures and by conserving water both indoors and outdoors; and

*WHEREAS*, water conservation will continue to play an important role in the future protection and preservation of ground and surface water resources; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida traditionally designates April as Water Conservation Month,

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Gib Coerper, Mayor of the City of Alachua, Florida, representing the City and the City Commission, do hereby proclaim April 2015, as
