

Church bells, kind acts mark 2 years since Boston bombings

BOSTON — With a moment of silence, the toll-ing of church bells and a call for kindness, Boston marked the second anniversary of the marathon bombings Wednesday the emotions Wednesday, the emotions

clearly still raw from the devastating attack during one of this city's most cherished events.

On Boylston Street, On Boylston Street, people openly wept and hugged as church bells tolled at 2:49 p.m., the time the first bomb went off at the race's finish line April 15, 2013. "It still feels like yester-day, to be honest," said Aleksander Jonca, a Boston resident who ran the marathon in 2013 and


