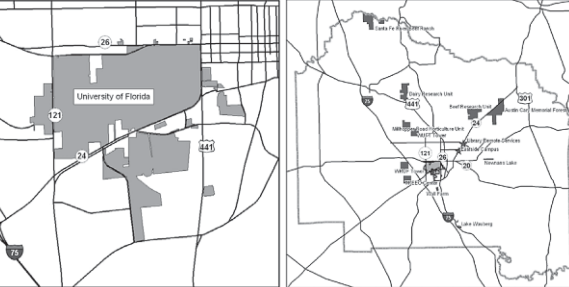
The University of Florida proposes to adopt a campus master plan to govern the use of land within the area shown on the map in this advertisement for the years 2015 – 2025.

A public hearing on the campus master plan will be held on June 4, 2015 at 3:40 PM at Emerson Alumni Hall (1938 W. University Avenue), Room 215B. Interested parties are invited to appear at the public hearing and be heard regarding the proposed campus master plan. Public parking will be provided in a designated area in the northeast corner of the O'Connell Center parking lot during the time of the hearing. Interested parties who cannot attend this hearing are invited to submit written comments to Linda Dixon, Planning Director, P.O. Box 115050, Gainesville, Florida 32611 or at ldixon@ufl.edu, which must be received no later than 5:00 PM on June 3, 2015. The agenda for the public hearing will consist of substantially the following: (i) University of Florida staff will make a brief presentation to include an overview of the relevant statutory requirements and master planning process; the review, public hearing, and approval processes; the general content of the proposed master plan; the proposed master plan's projected impacts; and any modifications made to the plan based on local government or other public input; (ii) public comment will be heard; and (iii) the University of Florida Board of Trustees will discuss, and vote on adoption of, the campus master plan.

A copy of the proposed campus master plan and meeting agenda are available for inspection at the University's [Planning, Design, and Construction Division, 232 Stadium, University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida](#) during the [normal business hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm](#), or online at www.masterplan.ufl.edu.

Within 45 days of adoption of the master plan by the Board of Trustees, the University shall provide written notice of adoption to any affected person, as defined in §1013.30(2)(b), Florida Statutes. Affected persons may petition the University of Florida Board of Trustees challenging the adopted campus master plan by submitting a petition within the timeframe, and meeting the requirements, set forth in §1013.30(7), Florida Statutes.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodation in order to attend and participate in this public hearing is asked to advise the University of Florida at least 48 hours in advance by contacting the Planning Design and Construction office at (352) 273-4000.
