AGENDA ITEM

A. Workshop: Introduction-FY16 Budget Process

Finance Director Marcian Brown introduced the item and provided the staff report.

Vice Mayor Ben Boukari, Jr., asked for clarification about property appraiser's assessments and state revenue sharing.

Finance Director Brown provided a summary of the legislation and processes of the property appraisers that have an effect on city budgets in terms of revenue projections.

Finance Director Brown provided an overview of the budget calendar.

Mayor Coerper asked the commissioners for questions or comments.

Commissioner Wilford asked about the TK Basin Park dates and requirements.

Assistant City Manager Adam Boukari provided the dates, terms, and requirements with a brief history on the subject as well as a projected timeline for those items yet to come before the Commission.

Vice Mayor Boukari asked about the status of any particular legislation that is of concern to the City.

Finance Director Brown provided a summary of legislation he has been watching.

Commissioner Wilford asked about the potential impact to the City if it should join Fire MSTU, and if the City has been approached to join.

Finance Director Brown said he is not aware of any approach. He said if the City decided to participate the projected costs are about \$1 million in comparison to the approximate \$662,000 currently paid.
