

## **RESOLUTION 15-26**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2015 TAX YEAR; ADOPTING FINAL MILLAGE RATES; ESTABLISHING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM THE ROLLED BACK RATE; DIRECTING THE TRANSMITTAL OF CERTIFIED COPIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, at the public hearing of September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2015, the City of Alachua Commission adopted Resolution 15-22 approving the proposed millage rate and Resolution 15-23 approving a proposed general City budget; and,

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with applicable law, the City of Alachua Commission advertised its proposed millage rate, its proposed general City budget and the public hearing date and location for the adoption of the final millage rate and the final general City budget for September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015; and,

**WHEREAS**, said notice of proposed property taxes advised the recipients of a public hearing to be conducted by the City of Alachua Commission on this date for consideration of its proposed general City budget and the proposed millages necessary to fund said budget; and,

**WHEREAS**, the September 28th, 2015 public hearing has been held as specified in the advertisement and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA.

**SECTION 1.** That the following final millage rate to fund the final general City budget for fiscal year 2015-2016 is hereby adopted in accordance with applicable law;


General Fund 5.9900 mills

**SECTION 2.** The millage levied herein is more than the rolled back rate of 5.5290 by 8.34 percent.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by state law, to the Alachua County Property Appraiser, the Alachua County Tax Collector, and to the State of Florida Department of Revenue.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
