

RESOLUTION 16-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN AMENDED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CREATING THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL; REPEALING RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council was created pursuant to an interlocal agreement as provided for in Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, as amended, entered into on June 1, 1975, amended December 1, 1980, amended October 1, 1984, amended March 1, 1990, by counties and municipalities in the north central Florida region; and

WHEREAS, the member counties and municipalities are desirous to amend said interlocal agreement creating the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council: and

WHEREAS, the City is a member local government in good standing of the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Commission of the City of Alachua hereby adopts an amended interlocal agreement, dated September 24, 2015 creating the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council, and makes said amended interlocal agreement a part of this resolution by reference; and

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Alachua authorizes the Mayor of the City of Alachua, Florida, to sign said amended interlocal agreement; and

Section 3. All resolutions and parts of resolution in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
