In response to these concerns, County Attorney Michelle Lieberman stressed that they "are not waiving any rights with any party that is not a signatory to this agreement," suggesting the County will be able to respond to any future actions on the part of the City of Alachua.

She also reminded the Board that the agreement gives the County authorization to enforce its provisions and maintained that it offers a more permanent and trustworthy solution than litigation.


