The City of Alachua City Commission will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance on September 26, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. The hearing will be held in the James A. Lewis Commission Chambers of City Hall, at 15100 NW 142nd Terrace, Alachua, Florida.

The ordinance title is as follows:

ORDINANCE 16 - 17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA: AMENDING AND RESTATING IN TOTAL CHAPTER 30, TITLED SOLID WASTE, OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA CODE OF ORDINANCES, INCLUDING THE REPEALING AND REMOVING OF CHAPTER 30 RELATED ARTICLE II RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE, DIVISIONS 1. AND 2. OF APPENDIX A-FRANCHISES, OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF SECTION 30-40. COMMERCIAL SERVICES; AMENDING APPENDIX A, FRANCHISES, ARTICLE III, COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO CONTINUE A NON EXCLUSIVE COMMERCIAL FRANCHISE SYSTEM FOR THE COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS FROM COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES AND CHANGING THE TERM AND PROVIDING FOR AN AUTOMATIC RENEWAL OF A GRANTED FRANCHISE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES AND APPENDICES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

At the public hearing, all interested parties may appear and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance. Copies of the proposed ordinance, the Staff Report, and related materials are available for public inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, 15100 NW 142nd Terrace, Monday-Thursday between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. the Thursday prior to the City Commission meeting. **Written comments on the proposed ordinance may be sent to the following address: City of Alachua, Compliance & Risk Management Department, P.O. Box 9, Alachua, FL 32616.** Notice is given pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, that in order to appeal any decision made at these public hearings, you will need to ensure that a verbatim record is made.
