

RESOLUTION 16-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2016 TAX YEAR; APPROVING THE PROPOSED TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2016 the City of Alachua Commission certified to the Alachua County Property Appraiser's Office a millage rate necessary to fund the said proposed general City budget; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rates certified, on August 18, 2016, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and,

WHEREAS, the said notice of proposed property taxes advised the recipients of a public hearing to be conducted by the City of Alachua Commission on this date for consideration of its proposed general City budget and the proposed millage necessary to fund the said budget; and,

WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. That the following proposed tentative millage rate to fund the proposed general City budget is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law; General Fund 5.9900 mills.

SECTION 2. The millage levied herein is more than the rolled back rate of 5.8558 by 2.29 percent.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
