Pursuant to Section 180.136, Florida Statutes

The Alachua City Commission will consider rate increases to its Water and Wastewater services. The required public hearings will be held on Monday, August 8th, 2022 and on Monday, August 22nd, 2022 beginning at 6:00 P.M. Both hearings will be held at City Hall in the James A. Lewis Commission Chambers, located at 15100 NW 142nd Terrace, Alachua, Florida 32615.

Attendance is not required. However, the hearings are held so that utility customers will have the opportunity to comment on these matters.
