RESOLUTION 19-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, TO DEDICATE A PORTION OF I-75, BETWEEN MILE MARKER 399 TO 404, IN HONOR OF SERGEANT WILLIAM T. BISHOP, FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Florida Highway Patrol requested that the City of Alachua Commissioners support legislation to designate a portion of I-75, between Mile Markers 399 and 404 as the "Sergeant William T. Bishop Memorial Highway"; and

WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis signed into law on July 1, 2019 CS/CS/CS/HB 385 – Transportation Bill which states, "that portion of I-75 (26260000) between mile markers 399 and 404 in Alachua County is designated as the "Sergeant William T. Bishop Memorial Highway;" and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2017, Sergeant Bishop was tragically killed in the line of duty when he was struck by a motor vehicle while conducting a crash investigation on I-75 near the 403 mile marker southbound.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Alachua Commission supports the honorary designation of a portion of I-75, between Mile Markers 399 and 404 as the "Sergeant William T. Bishop Memorial Highway."
