

A video that began circulating online shows the man being charged by three dogs and falling to the ground. Two more dogs then join the attack. Several people passing by try to get the

dogs off the man. Police received a 911 call about the attack shortly before noon. Miami-Dade Animal Services responded and launched a dangerous dog investigation.

Police didn't immediately identify the victim and his condition wasn't known.

The School Board approved the employment termination of Joshua Gwynes, 31, for "misconduct."

The incident that cost Gwynes his job took place April 30. According to the notice of action obtained by the Times-Union, Gwynes allegedly pointed a "realistic replica firearm" at a student's head.







IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING POSTED NOTICE SIGNS

Pursuant to Section 2.2.9(D) of the City's Land Development Regulations, posted notice signs must be placed on the land that is the subject of the application, along each street which is adjacent to or runs through the land in a manner that makes them clearly visible. Signs shall be posted at intervals of not more than 400 feet when the land subject to the application has less than 1,500 feet of road frontage. 
