




Institute, a non-partisan research organization, said that sales tax losses, alone, could soon hit \$800 million-a-month, initially caused by the coronavirus shutdown but then followed by rising unemployment, which will slow tourist visits and consumer spending.

Florida's unemployment rate hit 12.9% in April, less than the national 14.7% level. But jobless numbers across the country are expected at least to near 16% by midsummer, which will have its own jarring effect on Florida's tourist-driven economy.

"In other words, as people from other states face job losses and are unable to travel to Florida, tourism-generated economic activity and the state's revenue suffers," said Robert C. Osborne, board chair of the Florida Policy Institute.

Florida Republican leaders, though, are holding out hope for an economic bounce back. They say that tax collections will begin showing signs of recovery with restaurants, retailers and that post-storm recovery assistance from utility crews based in other states might not be as large as in past years, as each state deals with issues related to the coronavirus.

Florida's emergencymanagement division has also been taking internal steps to ward off its own disaster fatigue.

"We're making sure that we're rotating people







IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING POSTED NOTICE SIGNS

Pursuant to Section 2.2.9(D) of the City's Land Development Regulations, posted notice signs must be placed on the land that is the subject of the application, along each street which is adjacent to or runs through the land in a manner that makes them clearly visible. Signs shall be posted at intervals of not more than 400 feet when the land subject to the application has less than 1,500 feet of road frontage. When the land subject to the application has 1,500 feet or more of road frontage, signs shall be posted at intervals of not more than 1,320 feet.

Signs shall be inspected by the City subsequent to their posting. The applicant shall be responsible for ensuring that the posted notice is maintained on the land subject to the application until the completion of the final public hearing on the application.

Signs must be removed by the applicant and returned to the City within ten days after the final decision on the application.




